# Brazilian real estate developer enters JV with US counterpart

Brazilian firm Veirano Advogados has helped real estate company Vitacon enter a joint venture worth US\$130 million with the US' 7 Bridges Capital Partners to develop properties in São Paulo.

Demarest Advogados advised Dona Elisa Moraes, which is 7 Bridge's local subsidiary. Dona Elisa Moraes will own a 20% stake in the joint venture, while Vitacon will control the remainder. The deal closed on 27 March.

Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe is also thought to have advised Dona Elisa, but Latin Lawyer could not confirm this prior to publication.
