Bloxs Investments fundraises BRL 1.75 million for distributed generation facility on Bahia

Bloxs Investments concluded equity operations for investors on Nordeste's first shared energy plant. The Adágio Solar Energy Plant was structured by the company Terra do Sol, hired for implementing an installation system of photovoltaic plates for the production of solar energy on Bahia's capital on Caminho das Árvores district, in Salvador. Overall, BRL 1.75 million was fundraised through the Bloxs Investments platform.

Copel believes that the energy auctions A-4 and A-5, which would take place in the month of April, will not occur on the planned date due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Pandemic affects demand up to 9%, affirms ONS

The spread of the novel coronavirus in Brazil has started to show its effects on the electricity sector. Accordingly to the National Operator of the Electricity System, due to the reduction of economic activity and of the change of work schedule in the country, a drop of 8.9% of medium charge on the country was registered in comparison to the last week.

New solar complex attracts more than BRL 800 million in investments in Bahia

The state of Bahia will receive BRL 827.8 million in investment for projects within the sector of renewable energy, coming from four companies. The memoranda of understanding were signed with the Secretary of Economic Development on March 17, in an initiative that promises to bring 1400 jobs for the region.

ONS: drop in consumption due to pandemic bring operation costs to zero

April's operations starts with the marginal cost of operation to zero in the entire country. This is the result of the country's recent circumstances with high influxes in the major parts of Brazil and, mainly, the fall of 8.1% on charge compatible to the projection of the National Operator of the Electricity System, for the next 30 days, besides the retraction of 6% on May.

Auction schedule continues despite of coronavirus

The progression of coronavirus arrived at a key moment for the government in relation to the auctions of this year, for existing energy A-4 and A-5, programmed for the end of April for thermic source, and for new energy A-4, scheduled for May 28. With less than 30 days for the former and 60 days for the latter to carry out the auction, which will contest renewable and thermic sources for new projects, Brazil has definitively entered into the pandemic route, however the auction schedule is still on course for now.

Auctions: Brazil reduced global average value for wind and solar-powered energy

Brazil played an important role on the issue of verified prices in the energy auctions in global terms. This is one of the findings determined on a report from the International Renewable Energy Agency (Irena), released in March. Another highlight regards its record of auctions already held, both in terms of frequency and quantity of energy contracted over the years.

Integrators of solar energy already feel the impacts of the crisis

Integrators of solar photovoltaic energy are concerned about the extent of the damage that the Covid-19 pandemic can cause on the distributed generation market. According to sources of the **CanalEnergia Agency**, the supply of equipment is guaranteed. However, agents have already noticed a slowdown in the demand for new equipment and fear the complete paralysis of the market.

Aneel package of measures prohibits power cuts due to payment defaults

The Brazilian National Electric Energy Agency approved on March 23 a package of exceptional measures to be adopted over the next 90 days, for tackling the effects of the coronavirus pandemic. A new resolution prohibits the suspension of electricity supply due to defaults on payment in residential consumer units and in essential activities, such as hospitals and healthcare units; centers for the production, storage and distribution of vaccines and antidote serums; water treatment and supply stations, among others.

The National Electric Energy Agency opened a discussion on Tuesday, March 17, about the regulatory treatment to be given to judicial decisions on the exclusion of ICMS from the PIS / Pasep and Cofins calculation base in consumer energy accounts. There are processes with decisions favorable to distributors, which have already been *res judicata*, which determine the return by the government of the amounts paid by these companies.

Cemig eases payments and cannot cut energy from the Social Tariff

A series of measures to assist the low-income population in the midst of the current health crisis and the spread of the novel Coronavirus was announced on Monday, March 23, by the governor of Minas Gerais, Romeu Zema. Cemig, for example, will make the flow of payments to the accounts more flexible and guarantee the supply of electricity to all customers registered as a social tariff, which cannot have their supply interrupted in the event of default.

Distributors suspend cuts and reinforce focus on digital channels

Following a decision by the National Electric Energy Agency, energy distributors are already beginning to adhere to the measures determined by the agency due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Enel and Neoenergia have already announced the suspension of power cuts for the next 90 days, in addition to strengthening their virtual services.

More distributors follow Aneel's decision and suspend cuts for 90 days

Equatorial Energia, which operates in the distribution of energy in the states of Maranhão, Pará, Alagoas and Piauí, commented on the measures taken by the National Electric Energy Agency in an extraordinary meeting on Tuesday, March 24. The company is also not going to cut power supply for 90 days to residential customers (Normal, Low Income or Residential Rural) and in units that have activities considered essential.

The National Electric Energy Agency authorized the entry into commercial operation of four generating units of the Porto do Sergipe I thermoelectric plant, located in Barra dos Coqueiros, in Sergipe, and owned by Celse.

The National Electric Energy Agency extended until April 22 the period for contributions of the public consultation that discusses the need to revise the rules for the replacement of transmission equipment at the end of its useful life. Abradee warns of imbalance due to exemptions in the electricity bill

The Brazilian Association of Electricity Distributors warned in a statement on March 19 that relief measures on the electricity bill during the coronavirus pandemic could lead to the imbalance of all companies in the electricity sector. Distributors are concerned about the approval of legislative proposals that may postpone the payment of the electricity bill or prohibit the interruption of the supply due to consumer default.

Distributors expect measures to offset Aneel's concessions

The Brazilian Association of Electricity Distributors said in a note on Wednesday, March 25, that it relies on the adoption of complementary measures aimed at maintaining the economic and financial balance of the electricity sector and "mitigating the effects of the concessions established by Aneel." The statement came a day after the regulatory agency approved a package of measures that includes a ban on cutting power supplies to defaulting consumers for the next 90 days.

Falling load can lead to contract renegotiation orders

For another day in which the peak of the instant load on the day was around 66.3 thousand MW, the prospects for reducing the Marginal Operating Cost for April are increasing. In view of the projected drop in the load, it is possible to affirm that the values for the next month will be below BRL 100.00 for the month and as the level of demand remains low due to the uncertainties about the progression of the covid-19 pandemic, values between the bases can already be seen at a maximum of BRL 60.00/MWh in May.

Abradee defends suspension of penalties during crisis

Distributors are advocating a definitive solution to the economic and financial impacts of the coronavirus crisis. The idea is to extend this understanding in a scope of solidarity that reaches all segments of the electricity sector and the federal and state governments. As it is not yet forthcoming, distributors are pressing Aneel for immediate measures to reduce the effect of falling consumption and defaults on companies' cash.

Proposal provides exemption from electricity bill for low-income consumers

The president of the Senate Infrastructure Commission, Marcos Rogerio (DEM-RO), sent to the Ministry of Mines and Energy on March 20 a proposal for a provisional measure that provides for up to 100% exemption from the electricity bill for consumers provided for in the low-income social tariff. The measure would be applied for up to three months, at the height of the coronavirus crisis, and would affect 8.3 million families, at a total cost estimated by the parliamentarian at BRL 1 billion.

Average PLD rises in three submarkets

The Electric Energy Trading Chamber (CCEE) informed that the Difference Settlement Price (PLD), in the calculation for the period from March 14 to 20, remained at base value in the North submarket and increased in the other regions.

Distributors negotiate 220 average MW at MVE

The Electric Energy Trading Chamber (CCEE) carried out the March round of the Surplus Sale Mechanism, in which the distributors negotiate surplus energy with free market agents. In all, 219.9 average MW were traded for the 3-month period, from April to June, in the Southeast/Midwest and South submarkets.

Fiesp asks for solution to leftover contracted demand

In line with a mobilization occurring between large consumers and other market agents, the Federation of Industries of the State of São Paulo asked the National Electric Energy Agency for a technical and normative solution for the surplus of contracted and unused demand, due of the coronavirus crisis. Fiesp considers that it is not correct to transfer the cost to the distributors, which offer the infrastructure, and suggests that a cyclical solution be found for the problem, through sector charges.

March Accumulation shows slight increase in energy consumption, says CCEE

Electricity consumption in Brazil in the first half of March reached 64,779 average MW, a slight increase of 0.4% over the same period last year, according to data released on March 18 by the Electric Energy Trading Chamber (CCEE), and which refers to the period prior to the worsening of the impacts caused on the economy by the spread of the novel Coronavirus.

Abraceel reinforces compliance with contracts in face of "force majeure" allegations

The Brazilian Association of Energy Traders instructed its members to observe compliance with bilateral contracts negotiated in the free environment, in the face of "possible allegations of unforeseeable circumstances or force majeure," to rule out the possibility of external interference in these transactions. Abraceel refers to a possible need to resort to arbitration to resolve conflicts between the parties, placing in the hands of third parties a decision that may have an unpredictable outcome for both sides.

Free market is more mature, says CCEE

After a year since the problem broke out involving some traders in early 2019, the assessment is that the free market used this event to reach maturity, says the chairman of the Board of Directors of the Electric Energy Trading Chamber, Rui Altieri Silva.

Asking for rebalancing of contracts is more feasible with drop in demand

The fall in load in Brazil has been noted for more than a week in the country. According to the assessment of the National Electricity System Operator, which foresees an 8.1% drop in April, this movement started to be verified precisely with the introduction of measures to restrict the circulation of people, mainly in São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro.

CCEE launches video classes to train agents and stakeholders in the sector

The Electric Energy Trading Chamber launched on Monday, March 23, a new format of video lessons for its market training courses. The contents, all free, varies from introductory topics regarding the sector to more technical approaches, available at Portal de Aprendizado.

Price falls in the free market for the second quarter

The price of energy on the free market plummeted for the months of April, May and June - with falls of 27.24% for conventional sources in the next quarter and a reduction of 20.91% in the case of incentive energy, according to the Forwar curve. released by Dcide, a technological solutions company for the electric energy sector. The reference curve is formed from a set of contracts registered collaboratively on the platform.
